- The media will extensively cover this protest. We must be cautious, as they tend to emphasise negative actions. Let us not provide them with any opportunity to overshadow our important message.
- To our dear youth, we understand your emotions and concerns. Channel these emotions effectively to convey a powerful and clear message and avoid any kind of hate speech.

your participation is aimed at aiding our brothers and sisters in Gaza and urging the government to act decisively to halt the ongoing war.


Let us unite for a cause that transcends boundaries and stands for justice and peace.

# YOUR RIGHT TO PROTEST



## KNOW YOUR RIGHTS BEFORE YOU ATTEND!



#### 1 IT'S NOT ILLEGAL TO ATTEND A STATIC PROTEST

- DO NOT BLOCK WALKWAYS AND ROADS
- STAY WITHIN THE CORDONED AREAS
- LISTEN TO THE ORGANISERS AND ANY RULES
- BE RESPECTFUL
- DO NOT COVER YOUR FACE (unless for religious or medical reasons)

### 2 ENGAGING WITH POLICE

- DO NOT ARGUE
- YOU <u>CAN</u> RECORD USING YOUR PHONE, BUT DO <u>NOT</u> GET TOO CLOSE.
- LISTEN TO THE DIRECTION BY POLICE
- BE RESPECTFUL

### 3 CONDUCT/CHANTS

- YOU CANNOT YELL DEROGATORY CHANTS
- DO <u>NOT</u> INCITE VIOLENCE
- NO TOLERANCE FOR ANTISEMITSM
- NO PROHIBITED FLAGS
- NO FLARES
- IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE, ASK POLICE OR OFFICIALS WEARING FLURO VESTS

### 4 WHAT POLICE MUST TELL YOU

- THEIR NAME AND RANK
- WHETHER YOU ARE UNDER ARREST OR NOT
- WHY YOU ARE UNDER ARREST
- YOU HAVE A RIGHT TO SILENCE
- YOU HAVE A RIGHT TO SEEK LEGAL ADVICE
- YOU HAVE A RIGHT TO MEDICAL ATTENTION
- WHETHER THEIR BODY WORN CAMERAS ARE ON (A LIGHT SHOULD BE VISIBLE ON THEIR SHOULDERS)
